



## FAQ's about E-Books and Where the Sidewalk Ends Bookstore

### 1. How do I know I am buying an eBook from Where the Sidewalk Ends?

In order to purchase the eBook from our bookstore, you must enter the Google eBooks online site through our website. We have links on several pages of our website all marked with the Google eBooks logo.

### 2. Can I use a Where the Sidewalk Ends Gift Certificate or use a store credit to purchase my Google eBooks?

We are sorry that the eBook system is unable to integrate with our in-store registers, and thus eBooks must be purchased via credit card online.

### 3. Can I buy eBooks for my Kindle through Where the Sidewalk Ends?

No. Amazon decided to keep the Kindle closed to other eBookstores. This means that if you have a Kindle you have no choice but to buy your eBooks from Amazon. We encourage you, if you considering an electronic device, to exert your freedom by purchasing a device other than the Kindle.

### 4. How are eBooks priced?

Just like regular books, publishers decide what the cover price of an eBook is, and they usually coordinate the price with the current edition of the book. The cost of the physical production of the books is actually a very small percentage of the cover price, which is why well-edited (and copyedited!) books are worth their value. Publishers are also pricing some eBooks substantially lower than regular books. The industry is in a time of flux right now, but the "agency model" adopted by most major and reputable publishers has brought some stability, which is why Amazon prices, for most titles from reputable publishers, are the same as the prices at other eBookstores.
